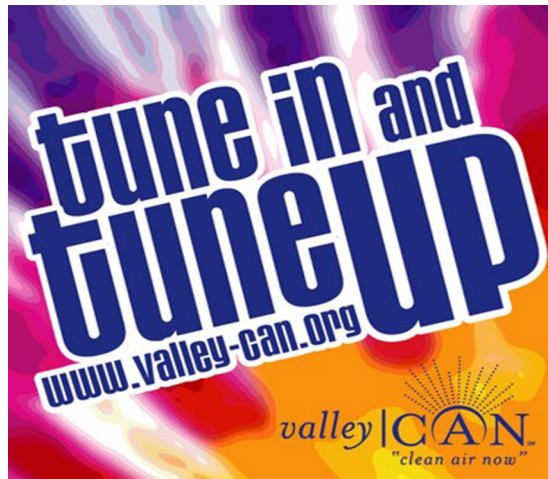

What is the Tune In & Tune Up Smog Program?

Valley CAN is proud to co-sponsor a car clean up effort to help reduce pollutants generated by "out of tune" cars in the San Gabriel Valley. The Valley is home to a large number of older cars, many of which do not pass smog check. The Tune In & Tune Up Program helps vehicles owners take voluntary steps to improve air quality.

How Do I Participate?

Bring your vehicle to East Los Angeles College on July 11, 2009. Initial emission tests will be conducted in minutes with emission testing devices. If necessary, you will proceed to the diagnostic station on-site where automotive students will perform under hood diagnostics.

What Happens If My Car Does Not Pass?

If your vehicle does not pass the emissions test, Rio Hondo College will give you a voucher for repairs at a local certified smog shop. No paperwork, No reporting, No government entities are involved or will be contacted. The Rio Hondo College-issued voucher can only be used for smog diagnostic testing or repair work up to \$500.

About Valley CAN:

Valley CAN is a private, non-profit organization that helps clean our air by promoting real-world solutions to our air quality problem. High polluting vehicles are a major source of air pollution in the San Joaquin and San Gabriel Valleys. Properly maintaining your vehicle's emissions is important, and Valley CAN realizes that many people have little time to inspect their vehicle's smog levels - which is why Valley CAN has developed its **Tune In & Tune Up** smog program.
